Data journalist **Dr. Meredith Broussard** is a professor at the Arthur L. Carter Journalism Institute of New York University, research director at the NYU Alliance for Public Interest Technology, and the author of several award-winning books, including *"More Than a Glitch: Confronting Race, Gender, and Ability Bias in Tech"* and *"Artificial Unintelligence: How Computers Misunderstand the World."*

Her academic research focuses on artificial intelligence in investigative reporting and ethical AI, with a particular interest in using data analysis for social good. She appeared in the 2020 documentary *Coded Bias*, an official selection of the Sundance Film Festival that was nominated for an Emmy Award and an NAACP Image Award.
